You may begin dropping off children in our childcare rooms at 8:45am

If your child(ren) will be in our childcare during WBF here are a few things we ask that you keep in mind:

- We don't charge for childcare, but we do love donations! Newberg Friends Church covers the cost for childcare workers out of our limited budget. If you can donate, this would be a terrific help in our ability to provide safe and quality childcare. Baskets for donations are on the tables during WBF.
- Please fill out the registration form for your child (even if you have done this in the past). Allergy and contact information is critical!
- Drop off time is 8:45am and pick up time is 11am. Please be prompt at pick-up time, as our childcare providers have other obligations.
- DO NOT bring sick children to WBF. If you are not 100% positive that your child is healthy, the best and most respectful action is to stay home and not expose other families to a cold or illness.
- We provide snacks for the children, but if you would prefer to have your child eat the snacks that you bring-let our childcare workers know. No snacks containing peanut butter please.
- Make sure to clearly label all of your child's belongings. (Bottles, sippy cups, pacifiers, diaper bags, etc.)

We may change classroom locations or age configurations depending on the number of children attending or childcare workers available. If you would like your child to move to another class, please see Michelle Akins.

Take time to read the "Check-In and Check-Out Procedures" located in your child's classroom folder. Make sure to initial your child in/out every week and use the security card provided.
